In **1964**, the U.S. Congress, by joint resolution, declared **October 9th** as Leif Ericson Day. Since then, the Scandinavian community both in the Philadelphia area and all over North America has held that day as a very special occasion.

Each year, a featured **Scandinavian** country is chosen, and this year that honor belongs to **Iceland**. We are happy to announce that Annie C. Humphrey, Professor of History at Rowan University will be speaking at the dinner., In addition, invited guests include Consuls from **all** the Scandinavian countries and members of the local community business and government.

The first segment of our celebration **begins at 11am when we launch our Viking Ship at The Western Launch area of Marsh Creek Lake in Downingtown, PA.** Come and see and greet our replica Viking Ship "**Norseman**" and her crew. At 12 noon ,there will be introductions of honored guests, as well as the reading of a proclamation from the President of the United States and the playing of the Star Spangled Banner and the National Anthem of Iceland, At the conclusion of this ceremony, a wreath symbolizing the encampment at Vinland, will be dedicated in honor of the life and accomplishments of Leif Ericson. The Viking Ship will then sail until about 2:30pm

Join us at **4:30p.m.** at the annual Leif Ericson Day banquet (reservations required) This year the dinner will be held at the **Hilton Garden Inn, 720 East Eagleview Blvd, Exton, PA** This is a great time to mingle with old friends, enjoy a good meal, listen to words from guest speakers, see our display of Viking artifacts, and hear news of our famous traveling Viking Ship "Norseman".
